

Feature	A user age 13 or older...	A Restricted User (under age 13)...
Creating an account	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can create their own account. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cannot create an account on their own. The user's parent must create the account, or the user's teacher can do so with parental approval.
Profile	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can edit their own profile and settings (location, biography, unique username, password, etc.). • Can choose who can see which parts of their profile. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cannot edit their own profile and settings. The user's parent controls this information. • Cannot share their profile publicly. Only the user's parent and other coaches (if the parent allows coaches to be added) can see the user's profile.
Discussion forums	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can participate in discussion forums at the bottom of articles and videos. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cannot participate in discussion forums.
Links to third-party sites	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can see and access links to third-party sites. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cannot see or access links to third-party sites.
Email	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can choose whether to receive email reports and newsletters from Khan Academy. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cannot receive any email from Khan Academy.

Coaching others	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can coach other users on Khan Academy. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cannot coach other users.
Adding coaches for yourself	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can share their progress information with other Khan Academy users (such as their teacher) by adding them as coaches or accepting coaching requests 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can add coaches and receive coaching requests only if their parent has enabled this feature.
Computer programming tool	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can create programs using Khan Academy's computer programming curriculum. Anyone on Khan Academy can view these programs, upvote them, and see who created them. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can create programs. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ The user's coaches will be able to see the program and who created it. ◦ Others who have a direct link to the program will be able to view the program but won't be able to see who created it. ◦ The program will not appear on any public lists. ◦ No one will be able to upvote the program.
